1) Competition compliance reminder

FCE Secretary General reminded all participants to comply with competition law and circulated the Do's and Don'ts.

2) Status of PSR/PSD3 adoption

- The Secretary General provided an update to the participants on the progress of the Council discussions. The most recent working party meeting took place on February 21st, during which Germany submitted a non-paper regarding the simplification of reporting and notification obligations. Germany proposed deleting Article 39 of PSD3 in its current form and reintroducing effective powers for NCAs to act against non-licensed activities, replacing the enforcement of the notification duty. The next working party meeting is scheduled for March 19th.
- It was clarified that this non-paper is intended solely for Member States to discuss the topic. At this stage, it is unclear whether it will lead to the reopening of discussions on LNE and notification requirements, nor is it possible to assess whether it will negatively impact the industry or, conversely, reduce administrative burdens.

Action

The Secretariat will continue to closely monitor discussions related to the adoption of the PSR/PSD3.

3) 2025 Action Plan proposal

- In light of Germany's non-paper proposal, it was agreed that FCE should meet as soon as possible with the European Commission (DG FISMA), Belgium, Denmark, Germany, and Poland to gain a better understanding of the state of discussions and assess the risk of reopening discussions on LNE.
- The position paper drafted by the Secretariat should be updated based on the information gathered during these meetings and finalized no later than mid-April.
- It was agreed that FCE's primary position should be to reaffirm that fleet cards should be excluded from the scope of PSR/PSD3. If not, FCE should advocate for a more efficient, harmonized, and less burdensome oversight mechanism by NCAs.
- The Action Plan will be reassessed during the next WG meeting, after which the updated position paper should be disseminated, and meeting requests sent to a broader audience to reactivate or rebuild the FCE network on the topic.

New Action

The Secretariat will:

- request meetings with the European Commission (DG FISMA), Belgium, Denmark, Germany, and Poland,

- update the draft position paper.

Working group members will be kept regularly informed, and additional meetings will be held to prepare potential meetings. Members will be informed in due time.
