1) Competition compliance reminder

FCE Secretary General reminded all participants to comply with competition law and circulated the Do's and Don'ts.

2) Status of PSR/PSD3 adoption

- The Secretary General provided participants with an update on the ongoing Council discussions. The most recent Working Party meetings took place on April 24 and 29, with the next meeting scheduled for May 15. According to available information, Member States are currently discussing a revised definition of "agent." Aside from this issue, negotiations appear to be progressing steadily.
- The increased frequency of meetings suggests that the Polish Presidency is likely to achieve a Council Common Position by June, as planned. This would enable trilogue negotiations to begin no later than July.

Action

The Secretariat will continue to closely monitor discussions related to the adoption of the PSR/PSD3.

3) PSR/PSD3 PA Action Plan

- The Secretary General briefed members on the work carried out since the last meeting, drawing on the input received from members via the "LNE Notification Tracker" document and the questionnaire on the LNE notification process.
- Members agreed to revise the draft position paper "PSD Review and Application to Fleet Cards." Once finalized early next week, the paper will be circulated among the institutional stakeholders already identified. In a second step, members will consider whether it is appropriate to release the paper to the wider public. This decision will be based on an assessment by the Secretariat of the positions held by other trade associations, to identify any potential opposition to FCE's proposals. Based on the findings, the group will refine the dissemination strategy during the next meeting.
- Members reviewed the draft position paper "Need for Harmonisation of LNE Notification" and requested the Secretariat to adjust the language to adopt a more positive tone, shorten the country-specific challenge examples for conciseness, and remove Annex 1, which is not intended for external distribution. It was agreed that this position paper will be adopted at the next working group meeting. Initially, it will be shared with DG FISMA and the EBA to initiate a technical discussion, as well as with stakeholders who have shown particular interest in the topic.

Action

Members will:

- Submit their final comments on the position paper "PSD review and application to fleet cards" by COB on May 16, along with their company's updates on the "LNE notification Tracker".
- Send their responses to the LNE notification process questionnaire by June 6 at the latest.

The Secretariat will:

- Share the last updated version of the “*LNE notification Tracker*” with members.
- Revise the draft position paper “*PSD review and application to fleet cards*” following the meeting and circulate it immediately afterward.
- Promote the finalised position paper among identified institutional stakeholders.
- Identify EU-level trade associations that may oppose FCE’s position on PSR2 review.
- Revise the draft position paper “*Need for harmonisation of LNE notification*” and circulate it to members ahead of the next meeting.
